On Thursday, January 7, 2021, at approximately 1604 hours, I was dispatched to the intersection of Joe Frank Harris Parkway and Martin Luther King Jr Dr, in reference to a person walking in and out of traffic. On arrival I observed the suspect, Mr. Joshua Lang, walking in the crosswalk, then stopping and dancing, interfering with traffic.

Contact was made with Mr. Lang. Mr. Lang was under the influence of alcohol. The jail was contacted and it was approved for Mr. Lang to be placed in custody.
