On Saturday, January 9, 2021, at approximately 1253 hours, I was dispatched to 124 Euharlee Road in reference to a theft report.

Victim stated that at approximately 1145 hours on January 9, 2021, he noticed that his vehicle was not in the driveway from when he moved it out of the garage at approximately 1130 hours. Victim stated he also noticed that his keys and \$100.00 in cash was stolen from his wallet which was laying on a seat in the living room. Victim stated he was washing dishes in the kitchen with the TV volume turned up and did not hear anyone enter his residence. Victim also stated he found wet clothing that did not belong to him in his laundry room and a damp towel with blood residue in the back room.

The stolen vehicle is a 2019 Nissan Frontier white in color with GA Tag.

Approximately an hour prior to this incident, a black male subject identified as Mr. Trevus Baugh, was involved in a fatal hit and run accident approximately a half mile from where this theft occurred. After the accident, Mr. Baugh fled from the scene and into the wood line on the same side of the road way as the victim's residence. Mr. Baugh was seen by witnesses to have a severe head injury and was wearing clothing that matches the clothing recovered from the the victim's residence.

At approximately 1639 hours, Inv. Belcher advised the victim's vehicle was involved in another hit and run accident in Cobb County Georgia and Mr. Baugh was arrested a short time later in the area after fleeing on foot. The vehicle was recovered by Cobb County Police Department. Inv. Belcher stated that post Miranda, Mr. Baugh confessed to the motor vehicle theft and burglary at 124 Euharlee Road.

Warrants were taken for Mr. Baugh for Burglary and Theft by Taking-Motor Vehicle and added to the case file.

The vehicle was entered into GCIC as stolen and a GCIC entry form was completed and added to the case file.

The clothing and towel found was placed into evidence.

A GBI submission form was unable to be completed as the web site was down due to an unknown issue.

This incident was captured on my department issued body worn camera.
