On Monday, January 11, 2021, at approximately 2309 hours, I responded to 2335 HWY 411 (Motel 6), in reference to a wanted person who was staying in room # 148. Upon arrival, I made contact with the suspect, Mr. Thomas Robinson.

Mr. Robinson was known to have active warrants for probation violation through Gwinnett County Sheriff's Office and parole violation through the Georgia State Board of Pardons and Parole. The warrants were confirmed through Cartersville dispatch.

Mr. Robinson was handcuffed behind the back, double locked, checked for fit. Mr. Robinson was searched incident to arrest in which no contraband was located. Mr. Robinson was transported to the Bartow County Jail in patrol car 4255, and released into their custody. My patrol car was searched at the beginning of my shift, before and after each transport, with no contraband found.

The warrant information was added to the case file.
