On Monday, March 1, 2021, at approximately 1957 hours, I was dispatched to 10 Felton Place, Cartersville Beverage Company, in reference to a fraud report.

I then placed Mr. Louk in handcuffs behind his back where the handcuffs were checked for proper fit and double locked. I then advised Mr. Louk that he was under arrest for Forgery In The Fourth Degree.

I then searched Mr. Louk incident to arrest which yielded a clear, glass smoking device in his front left pocket which contained a white, crystal like residue. I then read Mr. Louk his Miranda Warning and he refused to speak with me.

I then transported Mr. Louk to the Bartow County Jail where he was turned over to the deputy there with no further incident.

My issued, marked patrol vehicle was searched at the beginning of shift, before and after every transport which yielded negative for contraband.

A warrant was taken on Mr. Louk for the above listed offense and a copy was uploaded to the case file. The smoking device was sent to the GBI Crime Lab for further analysis with charges pending results.

The photograph and smoking device was placed into evidence at the Cartersville Police Department.

This incident was captured on my body worn camera.
