On Thursday, April 29, 2021 at approximately 2242 hours I responded to Joe Frank Harris Parkway and Oak Hill Circle to back up Sergeant Cole on a traffic stop. While on the traffic stop, Sergeant Cole saw two people later identified as Ronny and Ricky Brawner riding their bicycles on the roadway (Joe Frank Harris Parkway) with no front lights on around 2301 hours. Sergeant Cole advised me that it would be good to go out with both Ricky and Mr. Brawner and that he would back me up. I had observed that Mr. Brawner had appeared to be in the right lane on Joe Frank Harris Parkway and did not have a front light on his bicycle.

I caught up to Ricky and Mr. Brawner in the area of 1225 Joe Frank Harris Parkway Atlanta Auto Brokers. I observed Mr. Brawner in the turning on Joe Frank Harris Parkway and Ricky was further down the road. I got behind Mr. Brawner and turned on my lights. I observed Mr. Brawner continue to go straight in the turn lane, cross over the gore, and continue to go straight on the shoulder of the roadway. I turned my siren on and off 4 times in an attempt to get Mr. Brawner to stop, however Mr. Brawner did not stop. Mr. Brawner looked back at my patrol car at least twice and Ricky looked back at me at least once.

Ricky was several car lengths ahead of Mr. Brawner and turned onto Leonard Drive. Ricky continued to ride down the roadway and Mr. Brawner followed Ricky. I lost sight of Ricky on Leonard Drive and I continued to follow Mr. Brawner. I left my siren on while chasing Mr. Brawner on Leonard Drive. Mr. Brawner eventually stopped in the area of 24 Leonard Drive and I asked Mr. Brawner where his friend (Ricky) went. While talking with Mr. Brawner I saw something in the corner of my eye.

I flashed my flashlight in the woods near the roadway and observed Ricky laying down in the woods with his bicycle. I advised Mr. Brawner come towards the front of my patrol vehicle and I told Ricky to come over to me. Ricky ignored my verbal command and proceeded to ride his bicycle away from me. I advised dispatch that Ricky was running from me and told Sergeant Cole where he was going. Sergeant Cole observed Ricky on Leonard drive who continued to run from officers.

While Officers were chasing Ricky, I handcuffed Mr. Brawner behind the back, double locked, and checked for fit. Mr. Brawner was searched in which no contraband was located. Ricky was eventually captured by officers in the area of Joe Frank Harris Parkway and Lipscomb Circle. Sergeant Cole searched Ricky in which a loaded syringe with a clear substance inside was located on his person. Ricky admitted to officers that the clear substance was methamphetamine and that it was his.

I had Bartow Dispatch run Mr. Brawner through GCIC. Mr. Brawner's GCIC return showed he had an active warrant#201655 for Probation Violation obtained on 04/16/21 through the Bartow County Sheriff's Office. Cartersville Dispatched confirmed that the warrant was valid and to place a hold. Ricky was also ran through GCIC and returned with no wants. Officers searched the area where Ricky had attempted to hide from officers, however no contraband was located.

Mr. Brawner was transported in patrol car 4282 to the Bartow County Jail and released into their custody. My patrol car was searched before and after transport in which no contraband was located. Ricky was transported to the Bartow County Jail by Sergeant Cole. The following warrants were secured for Mr. Brawner and Ricky:

Ricky Brawner

-Warrant Possession of Methamphetamine

-Warrant Obstruction (m)
