**On Friday April 30, 2021, at approximately 2030 hours I was dispatched to 1214 N Tennessee St (Crown Inn) in reference to a female on scene refusing to leave. Upon arrival I was told there was a male in the parking lot throwing beer bottles at people.**

**I went to the parking lot and observed Mr. Aaron Arthur Levi in the parking lot, threatening to throw a beer bottle at numerous bystanders. I approached Mr. Levi and took the beer bottle from him. I attempted to ask Mr. Levi for his name and date of birth. He responded with name calling. Mr. Levi removed his ID from his pocket and threw it on the ground. While running Mr. Levi's information he continued to be verbally abusive. Mr. Levi smelled strongly of alcohol and was unsteady on his feet. Due to his behavior and state he was placed in handcuffs, checked for fit and double locked for safety. Mr. Levi was placed in the rear of my patrol vehicle, the inside of which he immediately began to kick and head butt.**

**The property manager stated Mr. Levi had struck the front door of the business and was yelling at him.**

**As I was leaving the parking lot of the Crown Inn to transport Mr. Levi to the Bartow County Jail he slumped over in the seat, stating he could not breath. I stopped my vehicle and got Mr. Levi upright. Mr. Levi stopped responding to any verbal stimulus after this. EMS was notified. While waiting for medical assistance for Mr. Levi I briefly stepped away from my vehicle. Upon returning, Mr. Levi quickly slumped over again once he noticed me. Once he realized I had seen him upright and knew he was ok, Mr. Levi began to head butt the bars of my patrol vehicle.**

**EMS arrived on scene and transported Mr. Levi to the hospital. Due to his aggression I rode with him. Mr. Levi continued to be aggressive and verbally abusive to all individuals until medical staff sedated him.**

**Warrants were obtained on Mr. Levi for Criminal Trespass Damage to Property, Public Drunk, and Disorderly Conduct.**
