On Monday, May 3, 2021, at approximately 0947 hours, I was patrolling the area of Erwin St and Cassville Rd when I noticed a gold Mazda Protege (GA Tag) with no operational brake lights. I conducted a traffic stop in the area of Cassville Rd and Grassdale Rd and met with the driver of the vehicle, Ms. Janet Norris.

I advised Ms. Norris of the reason she was stopped and she stated she was unaware that her brake lights were not working. While at the window of Ms. Norris vehicle, I smelled an odor of marijuana and asked Ms. Norris if there was any marijuana in the vehicle. Ms. Norris stated her husband had recently smoked marijuana in her car and that is why there was an odor.

Ms. Norris was escorted from her vehicle and asked if she had any other contraband within the vehicle. Ms. Norris replied that she had methamphetamine in her vehicle. Ms. Norris' vehicle was searched which yielded approximately 3.7 grams of a white crystalline substance found in the front passenger seat.

Officers field tested the substance which yielded a positive test result for methamphetamine.

Ms. Norris was handcuffed behind the back, double locked, and checked for fit. Ms. Norris was searched incident to arrest in which no contraband was located. Ms. Norris was transported to the Bartow County Jail in patrol car 4268, and released into their custody. My patrol car was searched before and after each transport in which no contraband was located.

Warrants were obtained on Ms. Norris for Possession of Methamphetamine.

The white crystalline substance was placed into evidence for safekeeping.
