On Wednesday, May 5, 2021, at approximately 2105 hours, I responded to 12 Pathfinder St, in reference to an assault report.

Later at an accident that I responded to at approximately 0115 hours, Ms. Turner pulled up in the taxi cab she drives for a living to pick up a subject that was involved in the accident. I noticed she fit the description of what complainant described. Officer Sanders made contact with her and identified her.

Ms. Turner was placed in handcuffs behind her back, checked for fit, and double locked for safety. Ms. Turner was read her Miranda rights and agreed to speak with me. Ms. Turner stated that she and Complainant got into an argument and he pushed her off the back porch. Ms. Turner stated she beat up the Complainant, and her sisters had to pull her off of him.

Ms. Turner was searched incident to arrest for contraband and weapons, none were located. Ms. Turner was secured in the rear of Officer Sanders patrol vehicle and transported to the BCSO jail.

A warrant was obtained for battery (FVA) and a copy was attached to this report.
