On Tuesday August 24, 2021 at approximately 1619 hours I was dispatched to 254 North Dixie Avenue in reference to a theft in progress. Upon arrival I made Contact with the victim/ complainant who stated a unknown black male stole his pillow.

Victim stated he was talking to a friend when a unknown black male took his pillow. Victim stated the male had a red bag and took off running behind the business. Contact was made with a witness, Witness, who had the statement as Victim. Victim stated he wished to press charges for the theft of the pillow.

Contact was made with the suspect at the intersection of Dixie Avenue and Nelson Street. The suspect identified as Mr. Demetrian Fenn stated he traded a bag of popcorn for the pillow. Mr. Fenn stated there were witnesses. No witnesses were located to go along with Mr. Fenn's statements. Mr. Fenn was advised he would be going to jail for misdemeanor theft by taking.

Mr. Fenn was handcuffed behind the back double locked and checked for fit. Mr. Fenn was searched incident to arrest and no contraband was located. Mr. Fenn was placed in the rear seat of my department issued marked patrol vehicle and transported to the Bartow County jail for theft by taking misdemeanor. A warrant was secured and added to the case file.
