On Wednesday October 13, 2021 at approximately 1436 hours I was dispatched to 265 Cassville Road Dollar General in referenceto a theft in progress. Upon arrival contact was made with the complainant who stated two females were inside the store concealing merchandise. complainant stated one female was wearing a red shirt and jeans while the other female was wearing a black shirt, and black pants.

Contact was made with the female with the black shirt, and black pants identified as Mrs. Ashlea Amos. Mrs. Amos was detained, and asked if she was concealing anything. Mrs. Amos advised she was not. A search of Mrs. Amos' bag she was carrying revealed multiple items belonging to the store.

complainant collected the items, and scanned them. complainant returned with a receipt totaling \$87.21 for the merchandise Mrs. Amos concealed. Contact was made with the female wearing a red shirt, and jeans identified as Mrs. Amy Dipenti. Mrs. Dipenti was asked if she was concealing items. Mrs. Dipenti advised she was not.

A search of her belongings revealed she was in fact concealing items inside her bag. complainant collected the items, and provided a receipt totaling \$18.19. Mrs. Harvey advised she wished to press charges. Mrs. Dipenti, and Mrs. Amos were advised they were under arrest for misdemeanor theft by shoplifting, and were provided criminal trespass warnings.

Mrs. Amos, and Mrs. Dipenti were handcuffed behind the back double locked, and checked for fit. Mrs. Amos, and Mrs. Dipenti were searched incident to arrest, and no contraband was located. Mrs. Dipenti, and Mrs. Amos were placed in the rear seat of my department issued marked patrol vehicle, and transported to the Bartow County jail where they were released into their custody.

Pictures of the receipts were uploaded into the case file.
The encounter was captured on my department issued BWC.
